

Multi-hand Scoring Rules

Number of Players: 2-10

Game duration: 30-60 minutes for 2 players

Additional materials needed: Pencil and paper (or Multi-hand Score Sheet - see back)

This variant of **Bankruptcy: The Card Game** plays identically to the normal rules, with one exception. At the end of each hand, each player totals the point values for each remaining card in their hand. Keep a running total for each player. The point values for each card are described below:



Bear Market cards are worth a number of points equal to the number printed on the card. In this example, the card is worth 16 points.



Bull Market cards are worth a number of points equal to 5 times the number printed on the card. In this example, the card is worth 15 points.



Special Edition cards are worth 20 points each.



Stock Share cards are worth a number of points equal to the number printed on the card. In this example, the card is worth 6 points.

How to win: Once any player reaches or exceeds a total number of points equal to the number of players multiplied by 100 (i.e., 200 points in a 2-player game, 300 points in a 3-player game, etc.), the game is over, and the player with the **lowest** point total wins.

FAQ

Q: If I win a hand due to **Nation in the Grip of Deflation!** being played, the hand is over immediately and no one else can discard, right?

A: Well, you do win the hand, but the effect of the card still takes place for all players, so each player will still get to discard one card before hand scoring takes place. This can allow multiple players to score 0 for the hand.

Q: If I win a hand by playing a **Bull Market** card or **Inflation Strikes the Nation!** as the last card in my hand, does anyone have to draw any cards?

A: Yes, each player affected by the card must draw the necessary cards before hand scoring takes place.
